a. Treasurer’s Report: projected vs. actual.
- IV) Currently in the bank as of 1/14/19 the Band Boosters have **\$10,673.56** with \$8,076.00 in the CD for replacement of the entire marching band tower.
- V) There are deposits of \$1,308.98.
- VI) **However**, there are outstanding invoice payments in the amount of **\$3,821.66** which include concert season instructional staff and misc. bills.
- VII) So realistically, we have **\$8,160.88** at the moment.
As of 1/14/19: **\$19,430.88** is still owed to the Band Program through the Band Boosters.
We must continue to push the collection of band fees.
- VIII) Fundraising: Below is a listing of student profit from the following fund raisers:
19 students participated in the Yankee Candle Raiser and the profit was \$1,091.00.
6 student and 1 staff participated in the Poinsettia Fund Raiser and the profit was \$143.55.
11 students and 1 board member participated in the Citrus Fund Raiser and the profit was \$622.90.
Total revenue from the last 3 fund raisers \$1,855.45.
17 student signed-up for the Rock-a-thon. I believe 17 students participated in the Rock-a-thon. \$619.00 has been turned in from Rock-a-thon from 3 students. An additional \$71 in tips was turned in as well.

1. We will be getting 62 Uniforms

Assessment Boot Camp (1/26)

All-State Band Auditions (2/22-23)

- Students will travel to JMU on Friday, 2/22 and return Saturday 2/23.
- Boosters supply per diem for food.
