**II) Confirm Existence of a Quorum** – 10% of the general membership is required; 2018-2019 members general breakdown using 1 adult per band student, approximately 12 adults/120 students. Quorum was reached

**III) Reports**

a. Treasurer's Report: projected vs. actual.

- Currently in the bank as of 1/14/19 the Band Boosters have **\$10,673.56** with \$8,076.00 in the CD for replacement of the entire marching band tower.
- There are deposits of \$1,308.98.
- **However**, there are outstanding invoice payments in the amount of **\$3,821.66** which include concert season instructional staff and misc. bills.
- So realistically, we have **\$8,160.88** at the moment.
- As of 1/14/19: **\$19,430.88** is still owed to the Band Program through the Band Boosters.

**We must continue to push the collection of band fees.**

**IV) Fundraising:** Below is a listing of student profit from the following fund raisers:

19 students participated in the Yankee Candle Raiser and the profit was \$1,091.00.

6 student and 1 staff participated in the Poinsettia Fund Raiser and the profit was \$143.55.

11 students and 1 board member participated in the Citrus Fund Raiser and the profit was \$622.90.

Total revenue from the last 3 fund raisers \$1,855.45.

- All concert ensembles have been fitted for concert attire. We have purchased 1 additional tuxedo jacket, 2 dresses, and 1 jazz band shirt.

- Biggest volunteer jobs will be registration and overseeing stage changes
